

Sage 200c VIP FAQ's

Can Sage 200c VIP run on Apple?

You can access the product and view the screens, but you cannot print on an Apple product.

Will Premier HR and Premier ESS also be updated?

Sage 200 VIP HR and Sage 200 VIP ESS will be updated to enable integration.

Do I need to connect to the internet to access my payroll?

The product is not a cloud solution. It is still installed on your own PC or Server. It is only accessed through a browser; internet access is not a requirement to run the product. Access to the internet will however allow you to use new functionality e.g. Live Chat.

Is the Software 64 Bit compliant?

Sage 200c VIP is 32-bit compliant. A new version of the runtime is expected mid 2018, which will be 64 bit compliant. This version will allow the user to run on a 64-bit or a 32-bit machine.

What amount of data will travel on the server?

Information is loaded page by page. The full data file is not downloaded to the user's desktop, only the pages that you work with.

Will I still require a multi-user runtime?

Yes, a multiuser runtime is still required based on the number of users that will access the system at the same time.

Are there any new modules available in Sage 200c VIP?

No if you upgrade from Premier Payroll. If you upgrade from Classic Payroll, the following modules are available: The Africa Tax Module, Job Costing, Job Management, Old Mutual Pension fund, Sentinel, Advanced Leave Module, and Sage 200c VIP ESS and HR.

What are the major differences between Sage 300 People and Sage 200c VIP?

Sage 200c VIP is a Cobol product, with the same calculation functionalities and modules as VIP Premier Payroll. It is only different due to the improved screen design, better navigation options and the added benefit of being able to access your payroll from anywhere. Sage 300 People is a SQL based product with much more advanced calculation functionalities.
